Short Course

Christian Education: a practices approach

The short course programme consists of online lectures, group assignments, individual assignments, reading literature, completing a final assignment and participation in the on campus seminar. You should expect 420 hours of study for the short course, spread over the full duration of this course. That means that, beside the on campus seminar, you will need to spend around 19 hours a week on individual study or online group assignments. The on campus seminar is held halfway through the course, has a fulltime programme and participation is compulsory. During the on campus seminar you will have the opportunity to visit schools and, if possible, gain teaching practice in schools in the Netherlands.
